CTAA EXPO 2025

Executive Director Gayle Kludt and People's Transit Board Chair Andrea Del Grosso, recently attended the CTAA Expo 2025 in San Diego, CA.

In addition to the incredible and relevant selection of workshops to choose from, the Trade Show with a plethora of vendors showing and schlepping their wares, and the outdoor bus show where we could get an actual "feel" of potential fleet options, none of those vehicles held a candle to the sweet ride on display at the Welcome Reception.

This Volkswagen 1950's "forward control" light commercial vehicle is known as the Type 2. One of the original cargo vans, it spawned the advent of the van revolution. Built strictly for utility, the Type 2, which ultimately was

offered in several body types, was notorious for low horsepower but trustworthy performance. Under the hood, this Volkswagen Bus is powered by a flat 4 Cylinder engine, paired with a 4-speed manual transmission that offers an engaging driving experience. The combination of this engine and transmission offers a connection to the road that allows you to fully appreciate the vehicle's character. Safety and practicality are addressed with the inclusion of seatbelts, a feature that underscores the vehicle's blend of vintage appeal with essential modern amenities. This amazing piece of kinetic art caught my attention immediately. (My personal ride is a 2019 VW Beetle Convertible, complete with daisy swag on the doors, and also happens to be the last year the VW Beetle was made.)

Although the other side of the vehicle was retro fitted to accommodate beer taps, I saw an opportunity to upgrade our fleet with this 9 + 1 beauty with optional open seating on top for web netted lawn chairs. People's Transit for the W...I mean VW!!!
